**FROM HARTFORD:**

Take I-91 South to Route 9 (exit 22S) South in Cromwell. Follow Route 9 South into Middletown. In Middletown, take Route 66 (exit 16) East over the Arrigoni Bridge into Portland. Continue to follow Route 66 East approximately 4.5 miles from the bridge. The entrance to Saint Clements Castle will be on the right. Approx. driving time: 25 minutes.

*An alternate route:*

Take Route 2 East to Exit 7 (Route 17 Portland). Follow Route 17 to the end (approximately 10 miles). At the end, turn left onto Route 66 East. Follow Route 66 East for 2 miles. Saint Clements Castle will be on the right.

**FROM WEST:**

Take I-84 East to Route 691. In Meriden, follow I-91 North to Route 9 (exit 22S) South into Middletown. In Middletown, take Route 66 (exit 16) East over the Arrigoni Bridge into Portland. Continue to follow Route 66 East approximately 4.5 miles from the bridge. The entrance to Saint Clements Castle will be on the right.

**FROM NORTH:**

Take I-84 West, or I-91 South to Hartford. Take I-91 South to Route 9 (exit 22S) South in Cromwell. Follow Route 9 South into Middletown. In Middletown, take Route 66 (exit 16) East over the Arrigoni Bridge into Portland. Continue to follow Route 66 East approximately 4.5 miles from the bridge. The entrance to Saint Clements Castle will be on the right.
